




NOTE: Do not focus on the exact track. Impacts can occur well outside the area enclosed by the cone.

- A turn toward the northwest at a slower forward speed is expected tonight or Saturday, followed by a turn toward the north on Sunday.
- On the forecast track, the disturbance is expected to move over Cuba today, cross the Straits of Florida on Saturday, and then move near or over the west coast of Florida Saturday night through Sunday night.
- The disturbance is expected to develop into a tropical depression on Saturday as it moves across the Straits of Florida, followed by intensification into a tropical storm by Saturday night.
- Current center forecast positions through the next 5 days (if applicable) illustrated by dots
- White swath of potential track error added to each side of the forecast track through day 3
- Hatched swatch of potential track error added to each side of the forecast track days 4-5

** Swaths are calculated using average track errors and actual track may be well inside, or possibly outside the potential track areas indicated.











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






Expected Storm Total Rainfall and Chance of Rainfall Flooding








Key Messages for Potential Tropical Cyclone Four Advisory 1: 11:00 AM EDT Fri Aug 02, 2024



- Heavy rainfall may result in flash and urban flooding across portions of Florida and the Southeast this weekend through Wednesday morning. Isolated river flooding will also be possible.
- 2. Tropical storm conditions are expected Saturday night within the warning area in southwest Florida from East Cape Sable to Bonita Beach where a Tropical Storm Warning has been issued. Tropical storm conditions are possible in the Florida Keys on Saturday and along the Florida west coast north of Bonita Beach to Aripeka Saturday night and Sunday where a Tropical Storm Watch is in effect.
- 3. Coastal flooding is possible along portions of the west coast of Florida over the weekend.
- 4. Interests elsewhere in Florida and along the southeast coast of the United States from Georgia to North Carolina should monitor the progress of this system.



Marine Key Messages:

- Tropical Depresion Four is likely to form Saturday, either between Cuba and the Florida Keys or over the SE Gulf of Mexico.
- Tropical Storm conditions may be possible over the Florida Keys and its coastal waters Saturday.
- Tropical Storm conditions may be possible over the Tampa Bay area Saturday night into Sunday morning.
