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

NOTE: Do not focus on the exact track. Impacts can occur well outside the area enclosed by the cone.

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
- Milton will move toward the northeast at about the same speed through Thursday
- The major hurricane will make landfall somewhere between Port Charlotte and Cedar Key Wednesday night as a large Category 3 or 4 hurricane
- After passing over Florida, Milton will accelerate over the Atlantic while weakening and transitioning into an extratropical cyclone
- Current center forecast positions through the next 5 days (if applicable) illustrated by dots
- White swath of potential track error added to each side of the forecast track through day 3
- Hatched swatch of potential track error added to each side of the forecast track days 4-5
- ** Swaths are calculated using average track errors and actual track may be well inside, or possibly outside the potential track areas indicated.










Most Likely Time of Arrival and Tropical Storm Windspeed Probabilities

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











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


Likely river flooding for central Florida after Milton passes through


Key Messages for Hurricane Milton Advisory 14: 10:00 AM CDT Tue Oct 08, 2024

 Damaging hurricane-force winds and a life-threatening storm surge with destructive waves are expected across portions of the northern coast of the Yucatan Peninsula today.

2. A large area of destructive storm surge, with highest inundations of 10 ft or greater, is expected along a portion of the west-central coast of the Florida Peninsula. If you are in the Storm Surge Warning area, this is an extremely life-threatening situation, and you should evacuate today if ordered by local officials. There will likely not be enough time to wait to leave on Wednesday.

3. Devastating hurricane-force winds are expected along portions of the west coast of Florida, where a Hurricane Warning is in effect. Milton is forecast to remain a hurricane as it crosses the Florida Peninsula and lifethreatening hurricane-force winds, especially in gusts, are expected to spread inland across the peninsula. Preparations to protect life and property, and to be ready for longduration power outages, should be complete by tonight.

4. Heavy rainfall across the Florida Peninsula through Thursday brings the risk of life-threatening flash and urban flooding along with moderate to major river flooding, especially in areas where coastal and inland flooding combine to increase the overall flood threat.

Marine Key Messages:

- Dangerous seas are currently expanding across the central and eastern Gulf of Mexico
- Peak seas will recede by Thursday night over the Gulf
- Seas over the Atlantic will rapidly build on Wednesday and continue through Saturday
