



- Nico should maintain strength tonight while moving through the Windward Passage
- By Sunday afternoon, Nico is expected to shift NNW and track near or along the Lucayan Archipelago through Monday
- Gradual strengthening is expected over the warm waters surrounding the Bahamas
- Tropical storm and/or hurricane watches have been issued for portions of the Florida peninsula and the Florida Keys.
- Current center forecast positions through the next 5 days illustrated by dots
- White swath is potential track error through day 3
- Hatched swatch is potential track error on days 4-5

** Swaths are designed so the actual track will occur inside the cone two-thirds of the time. One-third of the time, the center will track outside the cone.

NOTE: Do not focus on the exact track. Impacts can occur well outside the area enclosed by the cone.








 Probabilities of sustained tropical storm force winds (>34 kt) over the next 5 days,


