





- Nico is expected to strengthen to a hurricane tonight over the warm waters surrounding the Bahamas
- Nico has turned NW and will track near the Bahamas through Monday night
- Gradual strengthening is expected to continue
- A hurricane warning is in effect for Florida from north of Golden Beach to the Flagler/Volusia county line
- Current center forecast positions through the next 5 days illustrated by dots
- White swath is potential track error through day 3
- Hatched swatch is potential track error on days 4-5
- ** Swaths are designed so the actual track will occur inside the cone two-thirds of the time. One-third of the time, the center will track outside the cone.

NOTE: Do not focus on the exact track. Impacts can occur well outside the area enclosed by the cone.


