

Location... 23.4N 76.4W
About 125 nm SSE of Nassau
About 325 nm SE of Palm Beach
Maximum Sustained Winds... 65 kt

Present Movement... NW at 9 kt

Size 34 kt... I 50 NE I 20 SE 60 SW 90 NW Seas to 24 ft



- Nico is expected to bring direct hurricane impacts to the most populated Island in the Bahamas this afternoon
- Nico is expected to continue NW towards east-central Florida through Tue before recurving to the NE by Wed
- Gradual strengthening is expected to continue
- A hurricane warning is in effect for Florida from north of Golden Beach to Fernandina Beach
- Current center forecast positions through the next 5 days illustrated by dots
- White swath is potential track error through day 3
- Hatched swatch is potential track error on days 4-5
- \*\* Swaths are designed so the actual track will occur inside the cone two-thirds of the time. One-third of the time, the center will track outside the cone.

**NOTE:** Do not focus on the exact track. Impacts can occur well outside the area enclosed by the cone.




