



- Nico has become embedded in the mid-latitude westerly flow and is accelerating to the NE
- As Nico transitions to an extratropical cyclone, the intensity will stabilize as the wind field grows
- A hurricane warning is in effect for the SE US north of Altamaha Sound to Surf City
- Current center forecast positions through the next 5 days illustrated by dots
- White swath is potential track error through day 3
- Hatched swatch is potential track error on days 4-5
- ** Swaths are designed so the actual track will occur inside the cone two-thirds of the time. One-third of the time, the center will track outside the cone.

NOTE: Do not focus on the exact track. Impacts can occur well outside the area enclosed by the cone.


 Probabilities of sustained tropical storm force winds (>34 kt) over the next 5 days, based off this cyclone's wind radii and track.







