








NOTE: Do not focus on the exact track. Impacts can occur well outside the area enclosed by the cone.

- Idalia is expected to strengthen into a major hurricane before landfall along Apalachee Bay on Wed morning
- After landfall, Idalia will weaken while it tracks along the Atlantic coast of Georgia and the Carolinas as a tropical storm
- Current center forecast positions through the next 3 days illustrated by dots
- White swath of potential track error added to each side of the forecast track through day 3
 ** Swaths are calculated using average track errors and actual track may be well inside, or possibly outside the potential track areas indicated.






























Expected Storm Total Rainfall and Chance of Rainfall Flooding



Risk of rainfall exceeding flash flood guidance within 25 miles of a point







Tornado Outlook – Day I and 2



Key Messages for Hurricane Idalia Advisory 12: 11:00 AM EDT Tue Aug 29, 2023

- 1. Catastrophic impacts from storm surge inundation of 10 to 15 feet above ground level and destructive waves are expected somewhere between Aucilla River and Yankeetown, Florida. Life-threatening storm surge inundation is likely elsewhere along portions of the Florida Gulf Coast where a Storm Surge Warning is in effect. Residents in these areas should follow any advice or evacuation orders given by local officials.
- 2. There is the potential for destructive life-threatening winds where the core of Idalia moves onshore in the Big Bend region of Florida, with hurricane conditions expected elsewhere in portions of the Hurricane Warning area along the Florida Gulf Coast. Strong winds will also spread inland across portions of northern Florida and southern Georgia near the track of the center of Idalia where Hurricane Warnings are in effect. Residents in these areas should be prepared for long-duration power outages.
- 3. Areas of flash and urban flooding, some of which may be locally significant, are expected across portions of the west coast of Florida, the Florida Panhandle, and southern Georgia Tuesday into Wednesday, spreading into portions of the eastern Carolinas Wednesday into Thursday.
- 4. Heavy rainfall from Tropical Storm Idalia is expected across portions western Cuba and may produce areas of flash and urban flooding as well as landslides.

Marine Key Messages:

Gulf:

- Seas are expected to peak around 33 ft
- Conditions will improve over the eastern Gulf by Wednesday evening

Atlantic:

- Seas are expected to quickly build off the NE Florida/GA/lower SC coast on Wednesday to 17 ft
- Conditions will improve off the SE US coast by Thu morning
