




NOTE: Do not focus on the exact track. Impacts can occur well outside the area enclosed by the cone.

- A track toward the west is expected until landfall along the south or central coast of Texas on Saturday.
- Some additional strengthening is expected, but Hanna is <u>not</u> anticipated to reach hurricane intensity.
- Current center forecast positions through the next 3 days illustrated by dots
- White swath of potential track is average track error added to each side of the forecast track through day 3

** Swaths are calculated using average track errors and actual track may be well inside, or possibly outside the potential track areas indicated.



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
Tropical Storm Hanna



- Guaranteed to be a tropical storm at landfall...
- Yet highest chances locally are 60% just south of Corpus Christi
- Timing: Late tonight along south and central Texas coast for tropical storm winds
- The earliest reasonable time of arrival of Tropical Storm Force Winds (34kt to 63 kt) for this cyclone based off the current track and wind radii.
- Clear or dark green are the lowest chances of 0-30%.
- Yellow to orange is 31-70%
- Red through purple are the highest probabilities of 71%-100%








Expected Storm Total Rainfall

MDT: 20%-50% MRGL: 5%-10%


Chance of flooding rain through Monday morning





Key Messages for Tropical Storm Hanna Advisory 6: 4:00 AM CDT Fri Jul 24, 2020

- 1. Hanna is forecast to strengthen and it is expected to bring tropical-storm-force winds to portions of the Texas coast, where a tropical storm warning is in effect.
- 2. Hanna is expected to produce heavy rains across portions of southern Texas. These rains could result in flash flooding and isolated minor to moderate river flooding.



Marine Key Message:

- Seas to peak near 15 ft Saturday morning offshore of the south and central Texas coast
- Seas will quickly recede on Sunday
